Dunedin also offers an Employment Service, supporting their journey to obtain and sustain meaningful employment.

Able has a clinical Supporting Parents Healthy Children Co-ordinator who will assist to strengthen family/whānau centred "best practice" at the personal, service practice and organisational level to meet SPHC Guidelines.

Able will work with communities to promote mental health and wellbeing and support family/whānau, friends and others affected by suicide or suicidal behaviours.

Able Timeout Carers provides individual supervised contact for children who have been exposed to issues around separation from significant people in their lives.


